FACULTY POSITION**

The position of **FACULTY MEMBER IN MATHEMATICS** is available beginning January 2012 in the Academic Affairs Division. This position is on a full-time, 10-month basis reporting to the Chair, Department of Mathematics.

FUNCTION: Responsible for teaching transitional, transfer/credit bearing, and statistics courses. Assisting with program curriculum development, learning outcomes, and co-curricular activities. Performing other faculty-related job responsibilities. Variable schedule includes evenings and Saturdays.

REQUIREMENTS: Master's degree in Mathematics or related field and at least two years of prior teaching experience is required. Ability to use technology in teaching is required. Preference may be given to candidates who have taught at a community college, engineering or advanced mathematics courses, or statistics and statistics education or who have experience with outcomes assessment, curriculum development, distance education, outreach to the public school system, service learning, or learning communities. Variable schedule includes evenings and Saturdays.

SALARY: Instructor rank on the 10-month Carroll Community College Salary Scale. Actual salary placement based on education and experience. Position includes excellent fringe benefit package.

APPLICATION PROCESS: Interested applicants must submit a cover letter, resume, and a one to two page statement of teaching philosophy postmarked by November 4, 2011 to the Human Resources Department at Carroll Community College, 1601 Washington Road, Westminster, Maryland 21157 or e-mail hr@carrollcc.edu.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION FOR FACULTY APPLICANTS: Generally, the College places new faculty at the rank of instructor, where the minimum based salary is \$36,867. One-half of travel expenses are paid by the College for the first visit to the campus. The entire cost of travel for the second visit to the campus is paid by the College. The College does not pay for relocation expenses nor does the College have tenure. However, following a one-year probationary period, year-to-year contracts are provided until three years of satisfactory service are completed, after which time 3-year contracts are provided.
