POSITION:

The Mathematics Division at Green River Community College is a dynamic group of individuals who are seeking innovative and creative faculty who are committed to the spirit of the mathematics education reform movement and have demonstrated this practice in the classroom. The Division encourages collaboration with colleagues to promote student success.

POSITION DESCRIPTION:

The successful candidate will teach courses ranging from arithmetic through differential equations, including statistics. Assignments may include developmental and a variety of college transfer classes.

In addition to teaching, responsibilities will involve student advising, assisting in curriculum development, and other college and division professional activities.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

- Master's Degree in Mathematics or Master's Degree in Mathematics Education

PREFERRED QUALIFICATIONS:

- Master's Degree in Mathematics
- Successful college level teaching experience
- Experience and desire to teach at all levels of mathematics including development courses, calculus and statistics. (Note: Master's Degree in Mathematics required to teach most college level math courses.)
- Demonstrated knowledge and successful incorporation of the AMATYC Standards into classroom teaching.
- Demonstrated interest and experience in the use of the technology in the classroom.

- Demonstrated ability to adapt teaching methods to meet the needs of students with diverse abilities.
- Documented evidence of ongoing professional development through professional organizations or activities.
- Demonstrated leadership abilities.
- Demonstrated successful experience working with students and coworkers who represent a variety of ethnic, racial, socioeconomic, and gender identities and/or students with disabilities
- Demonstrated written and oral communication skills in the classroom and with other professionals
- Demonstrated strong work ethic

TERMS OF EMPLOYMENT:

This is a full-time tenure track position beginning mid September 2010. The salary will be determined according to applicant's educational background, teaching experience, and applicable work experience. GRCC is an agency shop.

The position includes an excellent state benefits package including health and dental plans, participation in TIAA-CREF Retirement Plan, two paid personal days, sick days, professional leaves, tuition exemption, a faculty development program, in-service training, faculty excellence awards, and on-campus fitness center.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE:

To receive consideration, application packets must be received by March 15, 2010.

Application materials must be printed and submitted on plain, white bond paper without report covers or binders. Please do not staple materials.

Application materials must include in the following order:

- A cover letter that specifically describes how the candidate meets each of the MINIMUM and the PREFERRED QUALIFICATIONS

- Resume
- Copies of unofficial college transcripts
- Three letters of recommendation, written within the last year, at least 2 of which document your teaching experience
- One page typewritten response to the following (one page total, single spaced): We are interested in learning about your methods of teaching. If we were to observe your teaching, what would we see? (*Things you may want to address: What would you be doing? What materials would you be using? What would the students be doing? What assessments would you use to measure student understanding?*) Why would you make these choices?

SELECTION PROCEDURE:

A selection committee will screen all applications. Candidates may be contacted on a conference call. Selected candidates will be invited for personal interviews at the candidate's own expense in accordance with State of Washington travel regulations. Interviewees may be asked to give up to a 20-minute classroom teaching demonstration. Candidates requiring equipment must contact the Office of Human Resources no later than one week prior to the interview date. The selection committee will recommend finalists to the Executive Vice President.
