Required Qualifications:

- Master's or Ph.D. in Mathematics, Mathematics Education, or a strongly related field . Degree must be received by **July 1, 2009**.
- At least 18 semester hours of graduate level courses in mathematics
- Coursework that supports the candidate's capacity to teach the spectrum of courses offered by the Mathematics Department
- At least one year of recent full-time experience (or the equivalent) teaching mathematics courses typical of community college offering
- Demonstrated excellence in the classroom, including the use of appropriate technology
- Strong communication skills

Desired Qualifications: Preference will be given to applicants with one or more of the following:

- Leadership in programs for improving student success
- Documented excellence in teaching developmental mathematics courses
- Experience teaching mathematics courses designed for prospective elementary teachers
- Experience/potential for supervising undergraduate research projects in mathematics
- Experience/potential for teaching Calculus I, II, III and Differential Equations for engineering students
- Experience with a Computer Algebra System such as Matlab

Duties and Responsibilities:**Mathematics Faculty are expected to:**

- Teach the spectrum of courses offered by the Mathematics Department to include courses from Pre Algebra through Ordinary Differential Equations.
- Teach 30 semester hours per academic year on a schedule that may include early morning, evening, weekend, or off campus assignments.
