Essential Functions of Position:

Commencing August 19, 2010, a tenure-track faculty position will be available in the Department of Mathematics. Responsibilities include teaching and course development for the full spectrum of community college mathematics, from basic arithmetic through calculus and differential equations. Assignments may involve teaching courses in the evening. Other duties include keeping required office hours, full participation in departmental responsibilities including serving as department chair on a rotating basis, and participation in the governance of the college via committee assignments. Involvement in activities designed to improve teaching and particularly the application of technology to the instructional process will be expected.

Minimum Qualifications: The candidate must meet one of these criteria:

1. Possession of a Master's Degree from an accredited institution in Mathematics or Applied Mathematics OR Bachelor's Degree in either of the above AND Master's Degree in Statistics, Physics, or Mathematics Education; **OR**
2. A combination of education and other accomplishments that is equivalent to the above. (If claiming equivalency, attach a separate statement which presents the basis for this claim and submit supporting evidence, e.g., transcripts, publications, other work products.); **OR**
3. Possession of a lifetime California Community College Instructor's Credential in Mathematics **AND** a Master's degree.

Desirable Qualifications:

- Strong mathematical coursework, e.g., real and complex analysis, ordinary and partial differential equations, linear and abstract algebra.
- Teaching experience in mathematics, including remedial courses, statistics, and calculus.
- Some knowledge and/or experience involving non-traditional approaches to teaching that promote student learning.
- Demonstrated experience with using technology and multi-media in delivery of instruction and interaction with students.
- Competence in the use of technology, including graphing calculators, in instruction to increase student success.
- Demonstrated experience with development and implementation of student learning outcomes and utilization of results for improvement of student learning.
- Demonstrated experience with utilization of strategies, techniques and methods that enhance student learning and success and respond to diverse learning styles.
- Experience working with students from diverse cultural, ethnic, socioeconomic, academic and disability backgrounds.

Salary & Personnel Benefits:

The current salary schedule range for a tenure-track faculty position is \$53,668-\$89,668, plus an earned doctoral bonus of \$2,683. Starting salary is commensurate with academic preparation and experience. In addition to salary each full-time employee participates in a "cafeteria style" Health & Welfare Benefits Program.

Applications submitted online by Friday, February 5, 2010 @ 4:30 PST will be considered by the selection committee for personal interviews.

Application Procedure:

To be considered for this position, a complete online application including all required application documents (listed above) must be submitted via <https://jobs.sbcc.edu> by the above application deadline (please see above instructions to applicants). It is important that the online District Application form (Item #1 above) be complete and specific to fully indicate education, experience and other qualifications of applicant. "See Resume" is not acceptable.

You may attach additional supporting material to the online application under the attachment option entitled, "Other Document." (If you apply for more than one position, copies of all the required documents must be attached separately for each position.) Application and all documents submitted become the property of SBCC and are retained electronically.

Selection Procedure:

Online applications will be initially reviewed by the selection committee, which will recommend candidates for personal interviews at SBCC. After the initial interviews have been conducted, the committee & Dean will recommend the top candidates to the Superintendent/President for a final interview. The selected candidate will then be presented to the Board of Trustees for approval.
