2. Research on all aspects about this reality competition show.
3. Make a five-minute individual presentation on either of the dates specified above. **Missing on one of the two days means at most 50 points for this project score.**
4. Submit a report or the display board in the end of the presentation.

Grading criteria:

1. Originality^a: the aspect of invented works as being new or novel, and thus can be distinguished from reproductions, clones, forgeries, or derivative works.
2. Creativity^b: a mental process involving the generation of new ideas or concepts, or new associations between existing ideas or concepts.
3. Citation^c: a reference to a book, article, web page, or other published item with sufficient details to identify the item uniquely.
4. Set theory: Present your reality competition show with the following terms as many as possible: universal set, empty set, subset, proper subset, equal set, equivalent set, finite set, infinite set, Venn diagram, union, intersection, mutually exclusive, one-to-one correspondance.
5. Logic: amounts of usage related to various terminologies of logic such as deductive and inductive thoughts, negation, conjunction, disjunction, conditional, bi-conditional, and truth table.
6. **If you present with a display board (2- or 3-folds) showing your work, you are guaranteed to receive 60 out of 100 points. Giving a handout to or interacting with your audience members is a plus.**
7. **Your fellow classmates/audience members determine 15 of these 100 points. The more audiences show up, the more you receive these 15 points.**
8. **I get to determine the rest of 25 points based on 1 ~ 5 listed above.**
