How can we use a web site to better serve our students?

-
- What information/resources might your students like to have available?
 - What information might *prospective* students find helpful?
 - What resources would *you*, as instructor, like to make available?


-
- In MS Word, select Print from the File menu, then select **Acrobat PDFWriter** as the printer. Click OK.
 - Enter a file name, and be sure the type is set to PDF. I suggest you check the **View PDF File** checkbox. Click Save.

-
- In your web page, link directly to the file. For example:

```
<a href="document.pdf">Document</a>
```

- Include an icon or text with the link to identify the target as a PDF file.

-
- If you link to PDF files from your web page, also include a link to the Adobe download page for Acrobat Reader (free).



-
- From Adobe Acrobat, go to the **File** menu, select **Import**, then **Scan...**
 - Select a scanner.
 - Under Destination, click the first button to create a new PDF document, or click the second button to add the scanned page to an (open) existing document.
